Note: In most states, any boating accident that involves a fatality or injury requiring medical treatment beyond first aid or property damage over \$500 must be reported to the nearest state boating authority. Some states have lower property damage limits, so check your states website or go to www.safeco.com/statewatercraftregistration to link to your state's site.
